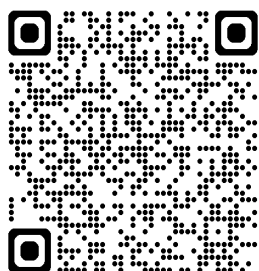

Description

All of our new Tailored Learning courses are matched to one of seven 'purposes' which have been designed by the Department for Education to recognise the wider benefits of learning.

This course will help build parenting skills and give you the confidence to support your children's learning.

Come and enjoy a relaxed and friendly course designed to help you support your child's learning through play, stories, songs and simple crafts — all based on much-loved children's books!

Each week, you and your child will explore a story together and take part in fun, hands-on activities inspired by the book. Along the way, you'll discover how sharing stories, singing songs, and playing together can boost your child's development and help prepare them for nursery or school. This course is a great chance to learn practical ways to support your child's early learning and spend quality time together in a supportive group.

Who is this course for?

This course is for you if you have preschool aged children and would like to do some activities together. Our courses are for people who live in Derbyshire aged 19 and over.

How will I learn?

This is a classroom-based course. There will be practical activities with guidance from your tutor. The course will be a mix of tutor-led activities and individual work. You will be given group tasks and can work on your own projects. Your tutor will give you support and feedback so you know what to do to improve.

What will I need?

Please wear clothes suitable for messy activities. You may want to bring something to make notes.

Are there any other costs?

This course is free and there are no other costs.

What can I do next?
