Love of learning	Religions and worldviews lessons foster a love of learning in children at Scargill through engaging and inspiring content and the opportunity to learn in a wide range of ways.			
Love of our community	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Every year a whole school Hospitality week, focusing on learning about how different worldviews view community, love and respect, provides opportunities for all children to consider why loving our community is important and demonstrate this in practical ways such as giving cards and gifts to local residents.</li> <li>• All children have at least two opportunities to visit St Wilfrids' church each year as well as a annual visit to the Well dressing, an important event for the local community.</li> <li>• Across all year groups children learn that many festivals and important life stages are celebrated and remembered by communities coming together.</li> </ul>

	<p>During their Reception year, children have regular opportunities to connect with members of the local community, including churches, to enhance their R&amp;W learning.</p>	<p>At Christmas time Y1/2 think about how they can share love for the community by creating art work for different places in the community, such as church and shops.</p>	<p>In year 3/4, children consider life as a journey and think about events they may have been involved in within the community, for example, joining clubs or attending village events.</p>	<p>In year 5, all children have the opportunity to visit the Open centre in Derby to experience and appreciate the diversity in our closest city.</p>
<p>Love of all people</p>	<p>Religion and Worldviews lessons focus on people; what they belief, think, do and value, through this learning children appreciate the joy of diversity and how we can learn with and from others ideas, beliefs and practices.</p> <p>In all year groups children have opportunities to meet people with different worldviews and experiences including visitors from Derby Open centre, trips including to Derby Open centre, visitors from locally represented worldviews and members of the West Hallam community.</p>			
<p>Love of God</p>	<p>Love of God is at heart of all Religions and worldviews learning, children find out about Christian beliefs about God and how these are expressed and make a difference to people’s lives. They also to learn about how people from other religious worldviews view God. Religion and worldviews provides opportunities for children to explore and express their own beliefs about God and to develop their personal worldview.</p>			
<p>Love of life itself</p>	<p>Through Religions and worldviews children explore their own personal worldview including what is special to them, what they value in life, what life and death are and what helps when life is hard. Thinking about challenging issues and exploring how different people think about these allows children to gain an appreciation of how unique and special life is – a love of life itself.</p>
