How are festivals and community important to many Hindus?

Hindu	Someone who believes in one God with many forms, including Vishnu, Brahman and Shiva.
Hindu Dharma	A way of referring to the Hindu religion, also called Hinduism.
festival	A celebration, often for religious reasons.
celebration	A fun event where people get together to be happy about something special.
benefit	A helpful or good thing.
value	How important or useful something is considered to be.
religious	Following a set of beliefs and teachings.
community	Friends, family, people and groups in your local area or who you have something in common with.

Celebrations and festivals are for the benefit of those who celebrate. They allow people to show that they think the values, people or events being celebrated are important.

Helping and support others is an important part of being part of community.
