Who is this course for?

How will I learn?

This is a classroom-based course. There will be practical activities with guidance from your tutor. The course will be a mix of tutor-led activities and individual work. You will be given group tasks and can work on your own projects. Your tutor will give you support and feedback so you know what to do to improve.

What will I need?
