Many Christians believe they should try to serve God and to bring freedom to others; for example, loving others, caring for them, bringing health, food, justice, and telling the story of Jesus.





Christians often see the story or Moses as looking forward to how Jesus' death and resurrection also rescue people from slavery to sin.

Most Christians believe the 10 commandments were given to Moses to guide people in how to live as part of the covenant.
