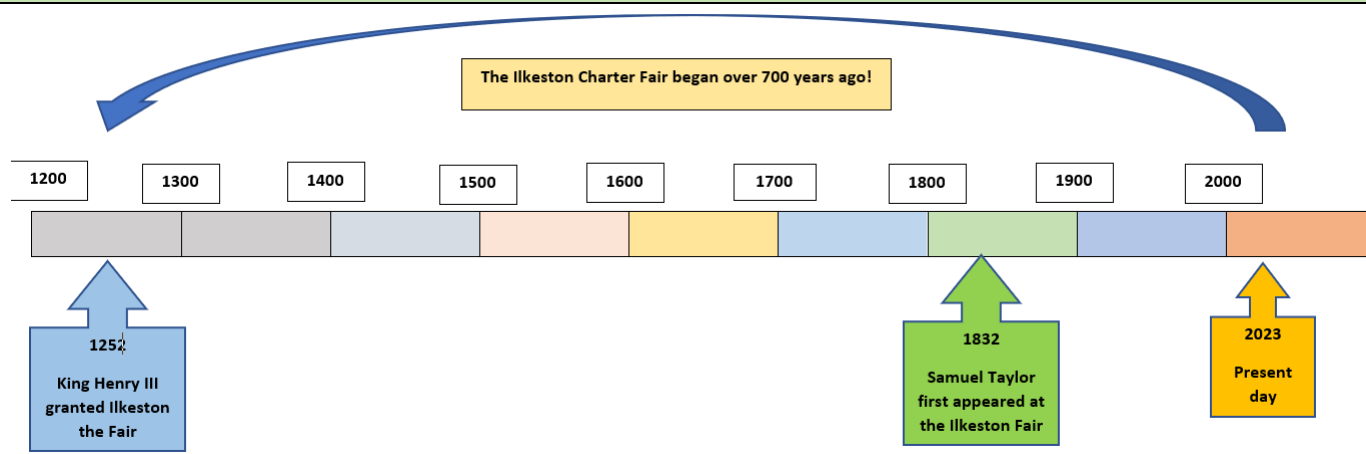

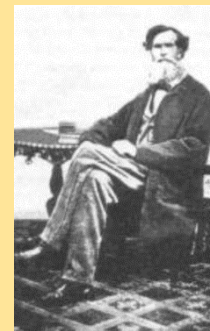
The Charter Fair

- King Henry III granted Ilkeston with the charter for the Fair in 1252. This is 771 years ago!
- The main purpose of the Fair would have been trading.
- In the 1800s, Ilkeston introduced another Fair called the Statutes Fair which took place in October.
- In 1840 the extended the Fair because it was becoming so popular.
- In 1888 the Assumption Fair and the Statute Fair were joined together and become known as the Charter Fair.



Samuel Taylor

- Samuel Taylor was also known as The Ilkeston Giant.
- He was a regular performer at the fair.
- His first appearance was in 1832.
- He stood over 7 foot tall!
