# What do Christians learn from the creation story?



<b>God</b>	A supreme being who some people believe created, watches over and rules the universe
<b>Christian</b>	Someone who follows Christianity, a religion based on the teachings of Jesus and the Bible.
<b>Genesis</b>	The first book in the Old Testament which contains the story of Creation and The Fall.
<b>Creation</b>	The beginning of the world and everything in it.
<b>The Fall</b>	When Adam and Eve sinned against God and fell from being close to God.
<b>temptation</b>	The feeling of wanting/having to do something you know you should not.
<b>interpret</b>	To explain or understand the meaning of something.
<b>steward</b>	A person who responsible for looking after something.

Genesis, the Creation story in the Bible, tells Christians that God created the world.



Many Christians believe that in the Creation story, God asks humans to be **stewards** - to take responsibility and to look after Creation for him.

Genesis also tells the story of 'The Fall', when Adam and Eve disobeyed God and let sin (bad choices) into the world.



In 'The Fall', God had commanded Adam and Eve to not eat the fruit of the tree of knowledge, but they gave into temptation, ate the fruit and so committed a sin against God. This damaged the relationship between God and humans.
