They need to bring:

a backpack with a bottle of water, this needs to be in addition to their lunchtime drink. packed lunch (no nuts or sesame/nut or sesame traces), or you can order a school packed lunch. separate waterproof jacket if needed.

If you wish your child to have a school lunch, please contact the office no later than Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May to provide your order. A school lunch consists of a sandwich, fruit, salad/veg sticks, sweet treat and a bottle of water. The children will be carrying their bag all day so please think about this when packing their lunch as boxes/cool bags are heavy and bulky.

We will begin our journey at 9am and return home at approximately 4.30. To maximise our time at the park and to consider the journey time we have made this an extended school day. This will be an exciting day consolidating our learning in science of animals as consumers and plants.
