Dear Parent/Carer

To support our Victorian history topic, we are planning to take our Y5/6 children to:

Place: Black Country Living Museum
Date: Thursday 21st May 2026
Voluntary contribution per child: £21.21

Children will need to wear:

- School uniform, preferably with school logo.
- Sturdy/comfortable shoes.
- Warm, waterproof coat as we will be outside for most of the day.
- Sun hat and sun cream

They need to bring:

- A backpack with a bottle of water, this needs to be in addition to their lunchtime drink.
- Packed lunch (no nuts or nut or traces), or you can order a school packed lunch.
- Separate waterproof jacket if needed.

*There are also a few different gift and sweet shops on site so children may bring **up to £5** in spending money. Please ensure this is inside a wallet or money bag as teachers will not be able to keep money safe (label the wallet with your child's name).*

If you wish your child to have a school lunch, please contact the office no later than Friday 7th May 2026 to provide your order. A school lunch consists of a sandwich, fruit, salad/veg sticks, sweet treat and a bottle of water.

The children will be carrying their bag all day so please think about this when packing their lunch as boxes/cool bags are heavy and bulky.

The trip will give the children a great opportunity to enhance their understanding of the topic and fully immerse themselves in Victorian life alongside taking part in either a metalwork or pewter casting workshop.

We will begin our journey at 8.00am and return home at approx. 4.30pm so please ensure your child is in school by 7.50am at the latest through the main entrance on Beech Lane. Pick up will be on the playground, the gates will be opened and we will keep you updated on the return journey by text message if there are any delays.

We will use the latest medical information and emergency contact details that we have on file. If any details have changed please inform the school office.

Please provide consent and payment via Arbor by **Thursday 23rd April 2026**.

As always, this trip will only go ahead if we receive enough contributions.
