

Welcome back Y3/4!

The World Book Day website (link at the top), is full of helpful information, including a range of family activities if you wish to get involved at home. There are:


Handy hints to create great, low-cost book character costumes,

In school, we are busy working with our children and school librarians to plan a memorable day for everyone.



