## What kind of King is Jesus?



<b>reign</b>	A period of time when a King or Queen rules.
<b>Kingdom of God</b>	God ruling over hearts and minds.
<b>incarnation</b>	A person who embodies God in the flesh, for Christians this is Jesus.
<b>parable</b>	A story told by Jesus to teach and illustrates moral lessons and ideas.
<b>Lord's Prayer</b>	A prayer Jesus taught his disciples which many Christians still use regularly.

Christians believe the Kingdom of God is, where God rules — not a country, but in human hearts and minds, lives and communities.

'Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.'

The Kingdom is compared to a feast where all are invited to join in. Not everyone chooses to do so.

Many Christians try to extend the Kingdom of God by trying to make the world a better place through their actions.
